- Students accepting their invitation into the Project Y program are committed to the program for the duration of the program in any given term.
- If you are going to be absent for Project Y, you must contact “explain” your absence through a parent note or parent phone call to the school office.
- Students must arrive to the Project Y program with the necessary equipment (that is, separate notebook, stationery and school diary).
- Students participating in the Project Y Program are expected at all times to follow instructions and abide by the decisions of the supervising teacher and community volunteers.
- Students are required to behave in an appropriate, courteous, safe and legal manner for the duration of their participation in the Project Y Program i.e. for the duration of the time spent at the Radio Station.
- Smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages or the taking of non-prescribed drugs is strictly forbidden. All prescribed medications are to be administered by one of the supervising teachers.
- Students are expected to be considerate of the general public at all times.

Serious breaches of this Code of Behaviour may result in the immediate return of individual students to Moranbah State High School, administration of appropriate consequences consistent with school policy and possible their withdrawal from the Project Y Program.
